-Some examples of when you should not drive are when you are:

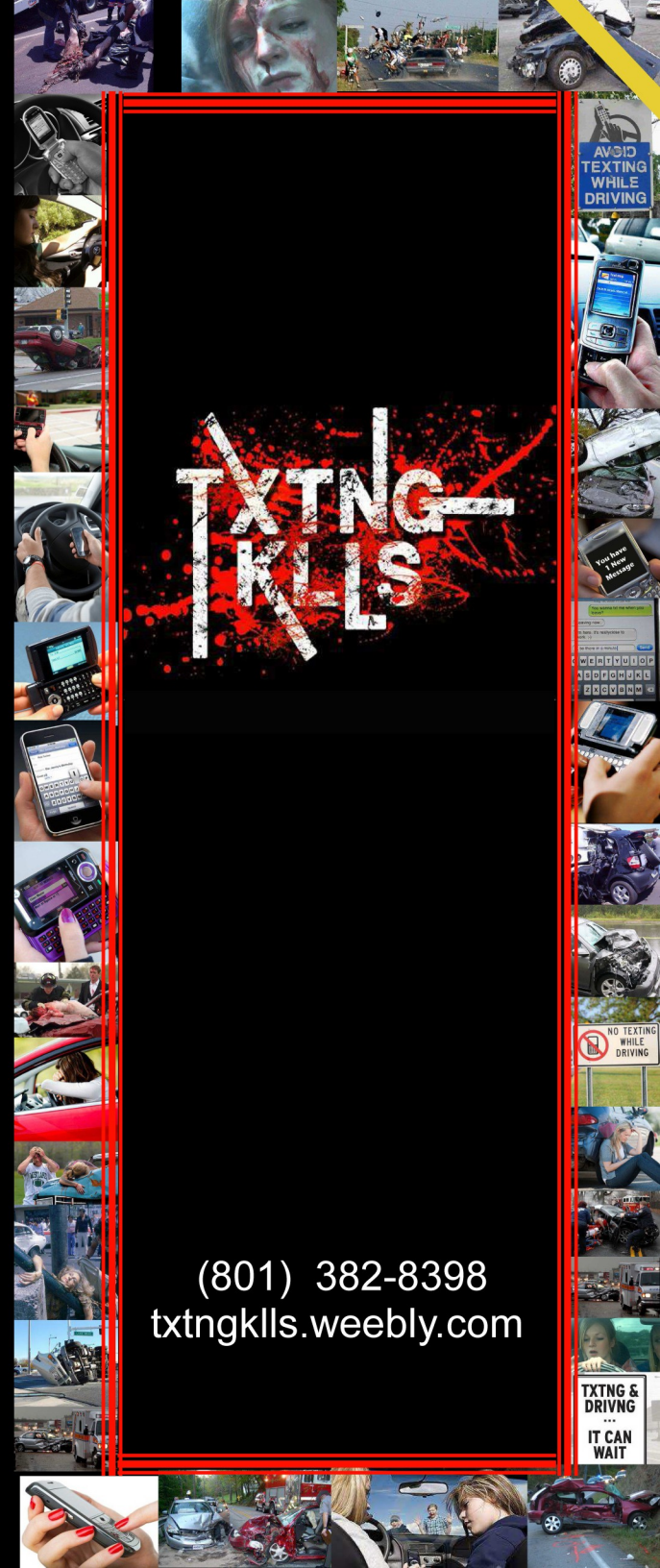
- Texting
